INCENDO PICKS UP FOUR CANADIAN SCREEN AWARD NOMINATIONS

Montreal, January 19th 2017 – Incendo, Canadian leader in television production and distribution based in Montreal, is very proud to announce that four of its productions have been recognized by the Academy of Canadian Cinema & Television at the 2017 Canadian Screen Awards. Nominees were announced yesterday by the Academy and include three of Incendo’s movies, as well as the hit international co-production series Versailles.

Canadian talent Evan Williams is nominated for **Best Performance by an Actor in a Featured Supporting Role in a Dramatic Program or Series** with his role of Chevalier in “Versailles”. The thriller movie “Amber Alert” is a nominee in the **Best Direction in a Dramatic Program or Limited Series** category, a second nomination for Philippe Gagnon’s directorial work with Incendo after “The Good Sister” in 2016. “Crossfire” is nominated for **Best Original Music Score for a Program**, highlighting the work of James Gelfand and Louise Tremblay. Lastly, the film “Swept Under” and its writers James Phillips and Doug Barber are nominated for **Best Writing in a Dramatic Program or Limited Series** following two nominations at the 2016 CSA for the Incendo productions “Kept Woman” and “Forget and Forgive”.
